Free Field-Based Teacher Workshop on the Coast

The Mission-Aransas Reserve, in partnership with The Nueces Delta Preserve, will be hosting a summer Teachers On The Estuary (TOTE) Workshop. The workshop will be held at three unique locations in South Texas: The University of Texas Marine Science Institute in Port Aransas, The Bay Education Center in Rockport, and The Nueces Delta Preserve in Odem. This FREE two and a half day workshop, scheduled **July 19-21, 2017**, is designed to help middle and high school teachers bring estuarine science into their classroom, laboratory and field programs. Workshop activities will focus on how humans impact estuaries, from function to biodiversity, and will be aligned with the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills. This workshop and its associated resources are provided by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's National Estuarine Research Reserve System.

TOTE workshop participants will receive:

- A free, two and a half day workshop on July 19, 20 & 21 (half day)
- Hands-on instruction featuring locally relevant research and interaction with the scientists who conduct it
- A \$175 personal stipend
- Supplies for classroom, field, or laboratory activities
- Visitation to three unique estuarine sites
